Let's Know About Literature In Bihar

Bihar is a land of many extraordinary people whose work and contributions have strongly influenced the course of events of the history of Bihar. Nationalist, writers, poets, artists, musicians, theatre artist, all have their fair share of contribution to the land.

Bihari literature, spread over two millennia, consists of literary works produced in various languages spoken in Bihar. These include Magahi, Bhojpuri, Maithili, Angika, Bajjika, Hindi, Urdu, Persian (Farsi), English and classical languages such as Sanskrit and Pali.

Magahi is derived from the ancient Magadhi Prakrit, which was spoken in the ancient kingdom of Magadha, the core area of which was the south of the Ganga and east of the Son river. It is believed to be the language spoken by Gautama Buddha to deliver his sermons.

Recently a book first-ever attempted of its kind to present a glimpse into the rich world of Bihari literature in English translation, drawn from many languages spoken across Bihar. Translations from languages such as Sanskrit, Pali, Magahi, Bhojpuri, Maithili, Bajjika, Angika, Hindi, Urdu and Persian have been included in the anthology. Many of these works have been translated for the first time, making these accessible to the English-speaking world.

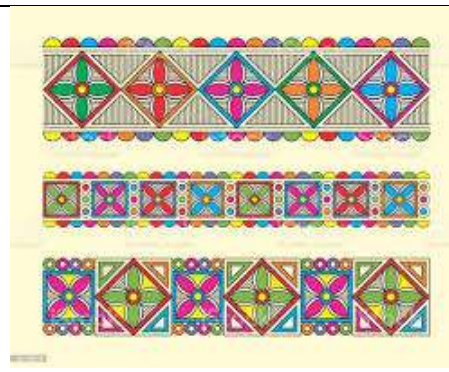
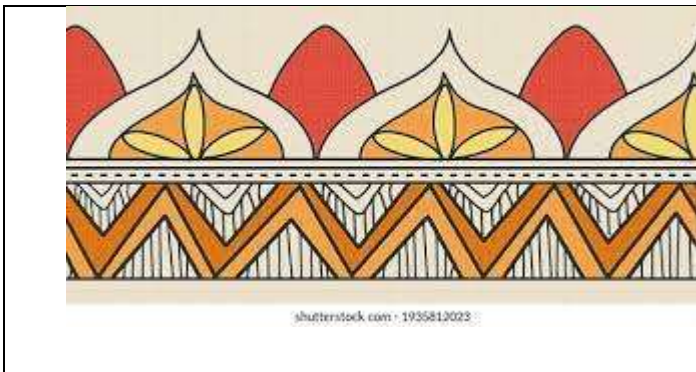
MATHEMATICS
