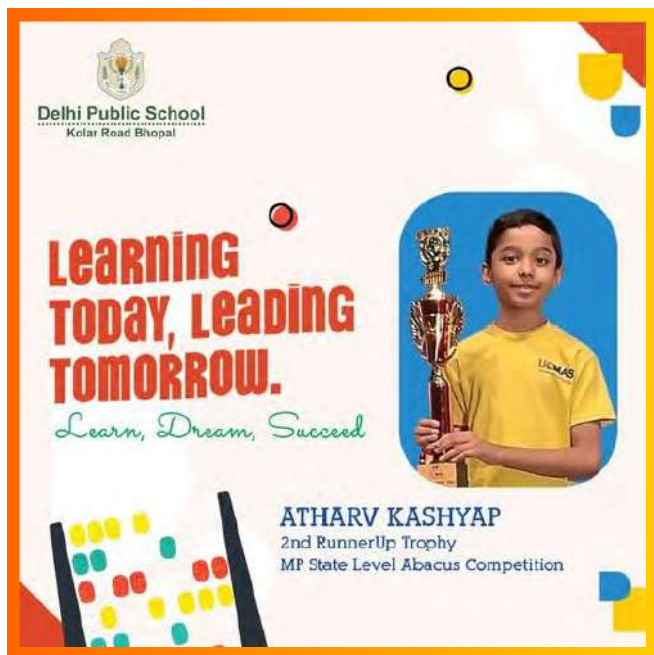
THE SHOW STOPPERS

sexual abuse. She also informed that 53% of boys too face sexual abuse and that Madhya Pradesh has the highest number of cases of child sexual abuse.

The resource person enumerated certain guidelines to be followed for POCSO cases and the prevention of such cases in our homes and schools.

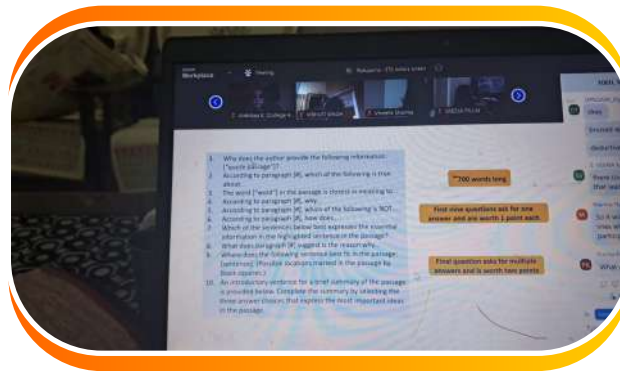

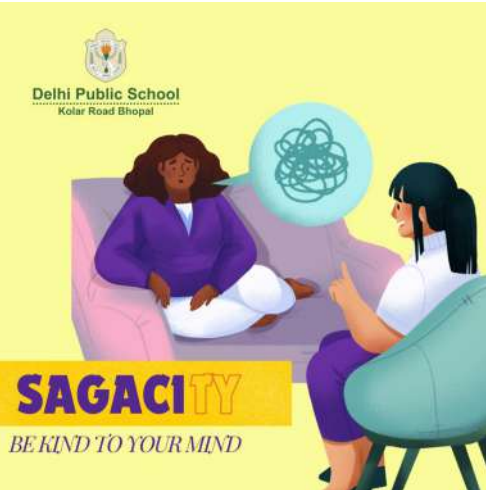
RESPECTING BOUNDARIES

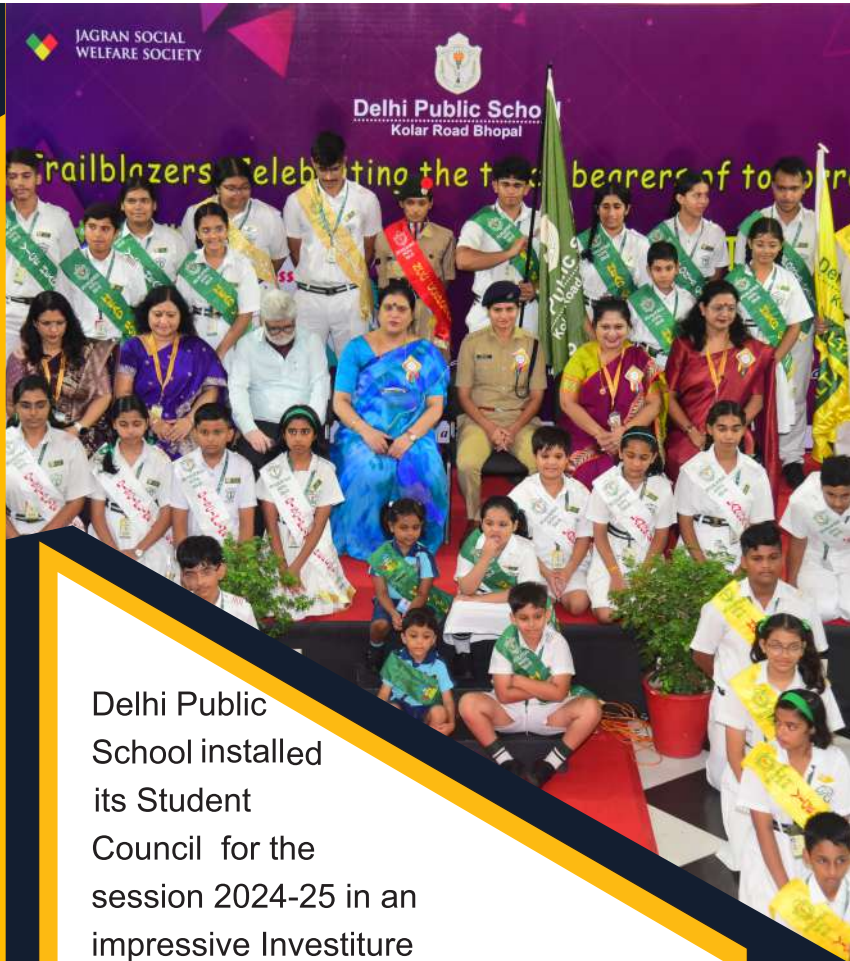
SCOUTS AND GUIDES CAMP

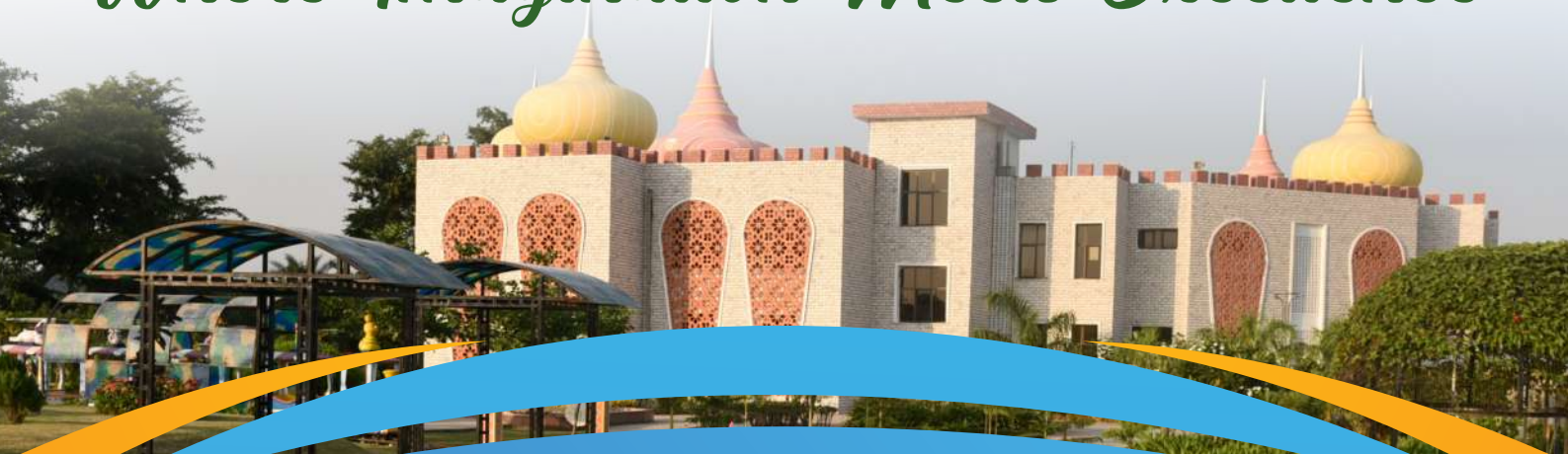

Glad Game.... The Spirit of Optimism

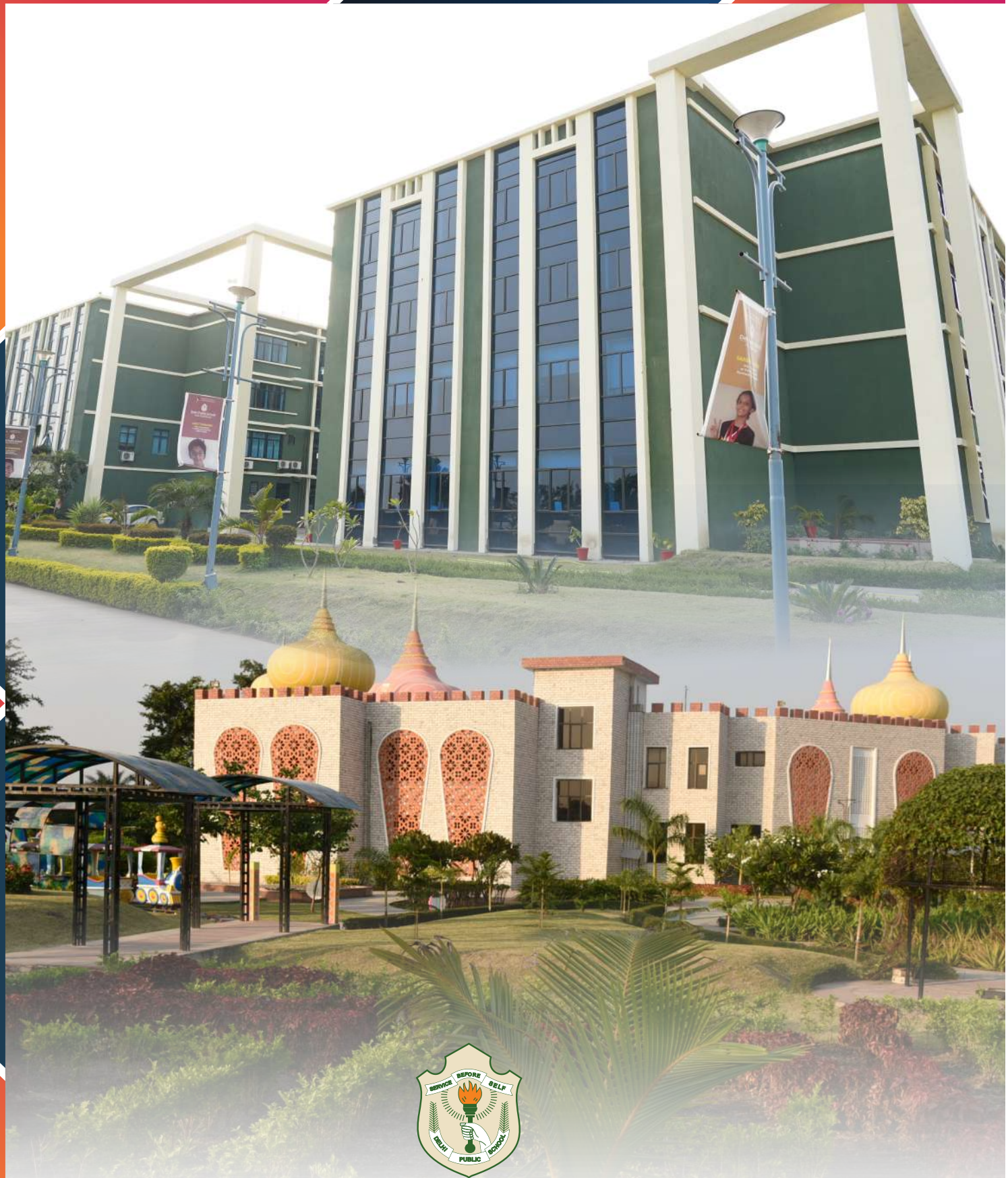
