1. Folk Culture Activity:

- Research and write a short paragraph on any traditional art form or craft of **Bihar** (for example: *Madhubani painting, Sujini embroidery, or Tikuli art*).
- Include pictures or hand-drawn sketches.
- Hints - How this art form reflects the culture, beliefs, and stories of the people of Bihar.

2. Character Journal – *Great Expectations*

- From the characters of *Great Expectations* (for example, Pip, Estella, or Miss Havisham).
- Write **3 character sketches**. (The Character you liked the most)
- Express their emotions, thoughts, and challenges.

3. Vocabulary Enrichment Task

- Choose 20 interesting or unfamiliar words from *Great Expectations*.
- Create a vocabulary sheet that includes:
 - Word
 - Meaning
 - Antonym
 - Usage in your own sentence

4. Creative Writing Task

- Write a book review of ‘Great expectations’.
- It should include: Title, author, name of the publisher, year (and place of publication), summary of the book (without giving the plot away completely), theme, characters, language, your opinion as a reviewer (Did you like the book? Why or why not?), conclusion (Would you recommend it?)
- Example of Book review is given on pages 36 & 37 – Gulmohar Language Practice Book.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

All sheets should be neatly handwritten, well decorated, and labelled.

Be as creative as possible — you can use colored pens, stickers, borders, drawings, etc.

1. FRENCH LANGUAGE BOOSTER

Use four A4 sheets for this section. Use one column for French, and another for English translation.

a) 20 *Adjectifs* (Adjectives)

Include a mix of:

- Colors: rouge, bleu, vert...
- Nationalités: français, indien, canadien...
- Descriptive: petit, grand, gentil, timide, fort, etc.

b) 30 *Noms* (Nouns) with Gender

- List 15 **masculine** and 15 **feminine** nouns

c) 10 Regular 'ER' Verbs

Examples: aimer – to like/love, parler – to speak, chanter – to sing

d) 5 'CER' Verbs (with spelling change)

Examples: commencer – to begin, lancer – to throw

e) 5 'GER' Verbs (with spelling change)

Examples: manger – to eat, voyager – to travel

Write their infinitive form, and conjugate at least three(3) in the present tense.

2. DIALOGUE TIME – Let's Talk French!

Write a dialogue in your French notebook between two friends chatting about their school life.

Your conversation must include:

- Greetings (Bonjour! Ça va?)
- Their favourite subjects (J'aime les maths.)
- Teachers (Mon professeur est gentil.)
- School timings (Mon école commence à 7h 30.)
- What they do during breaks (Je joue au foot.)

Characters: Give names to your characters (Ex: Emma & Lucas)

Add little drawings of a school, books, or speech bubbles for fun!

Minimum 10 lines. Use a mix of simple vocabulary and short sentences.

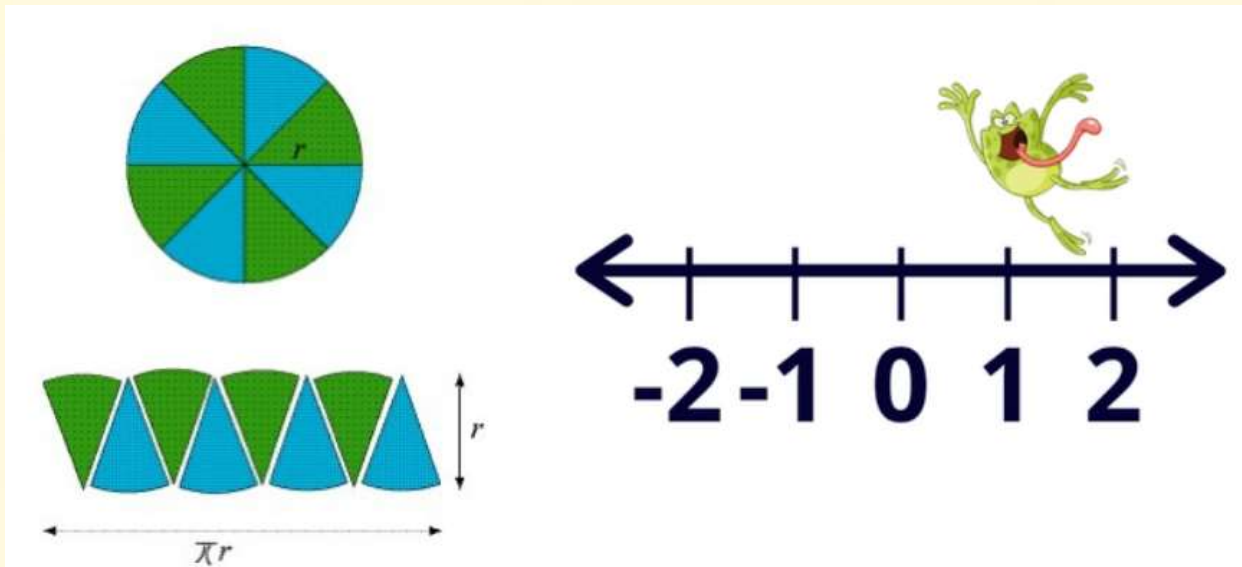
