

कलाम ने बाद में लिखा — "नेतृत्व का मतलब है असफलता की ज़िम्मेदारी खुद लेना और सफलता का श्रेय अपनी टीम को देना।"

यह घटना उनके जीवन भर के नेतृत्व के सिद्धांत की नींव बन गई।
