ADMISSION PROCESS



The process begins with the **STEP 1** submission of the registration form.



Interaction Session:
An interaction with the child is scheduled to understand their learning readiness and interests.

The outcome of the interaction is reviewed by the admissions team.



STEP 4

Provisional Admission:

Based on the evaluation, a provisional admission offer may be extended.

Confirmation of Admission:

Final admission is confirmed upon payment of the admission fee and submission of all required documents.

Throughout the process, the school ensures complete transparency and support for parents.
