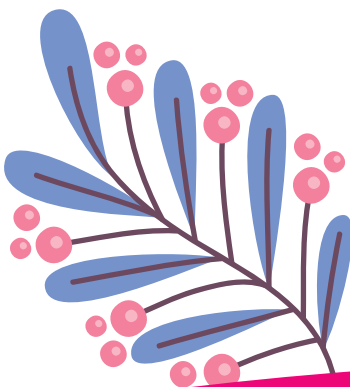

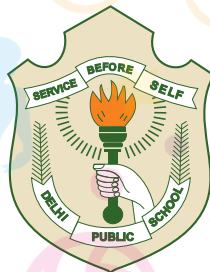

SAFAL (STRUCTURED ASSESSMENT FOR ANALYSING LEARNING) EXAMS

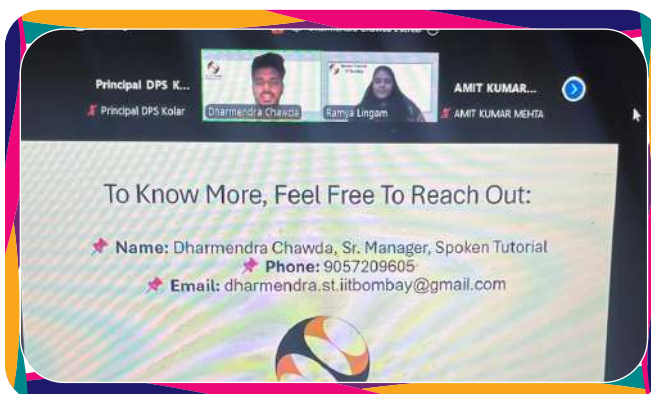

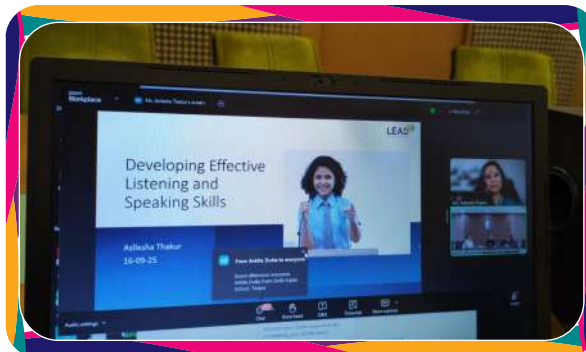
RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMME AT DPS HRDC TRAINING CENTER

FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT IN ENGLISH (HRDC)

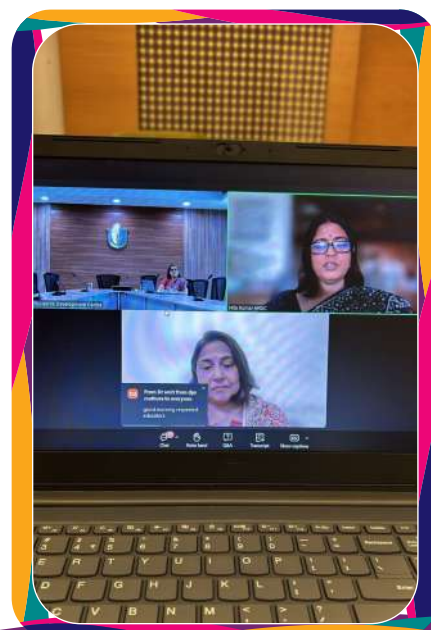
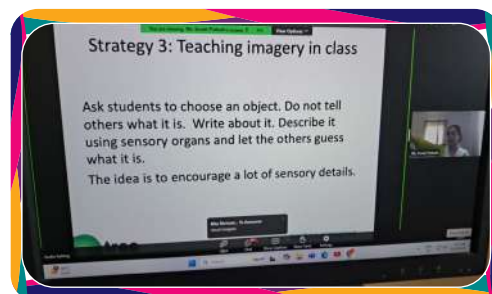

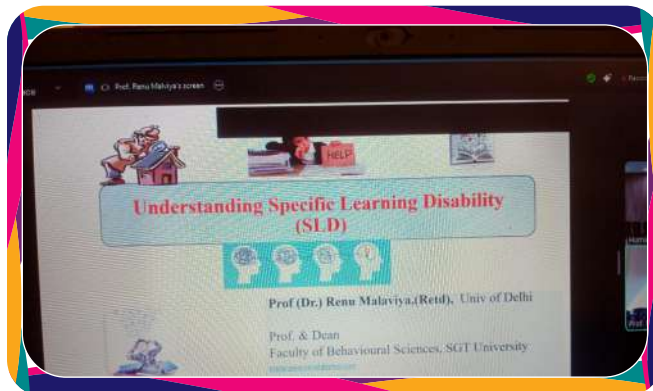
CREATIVE WRITING (HRDC)

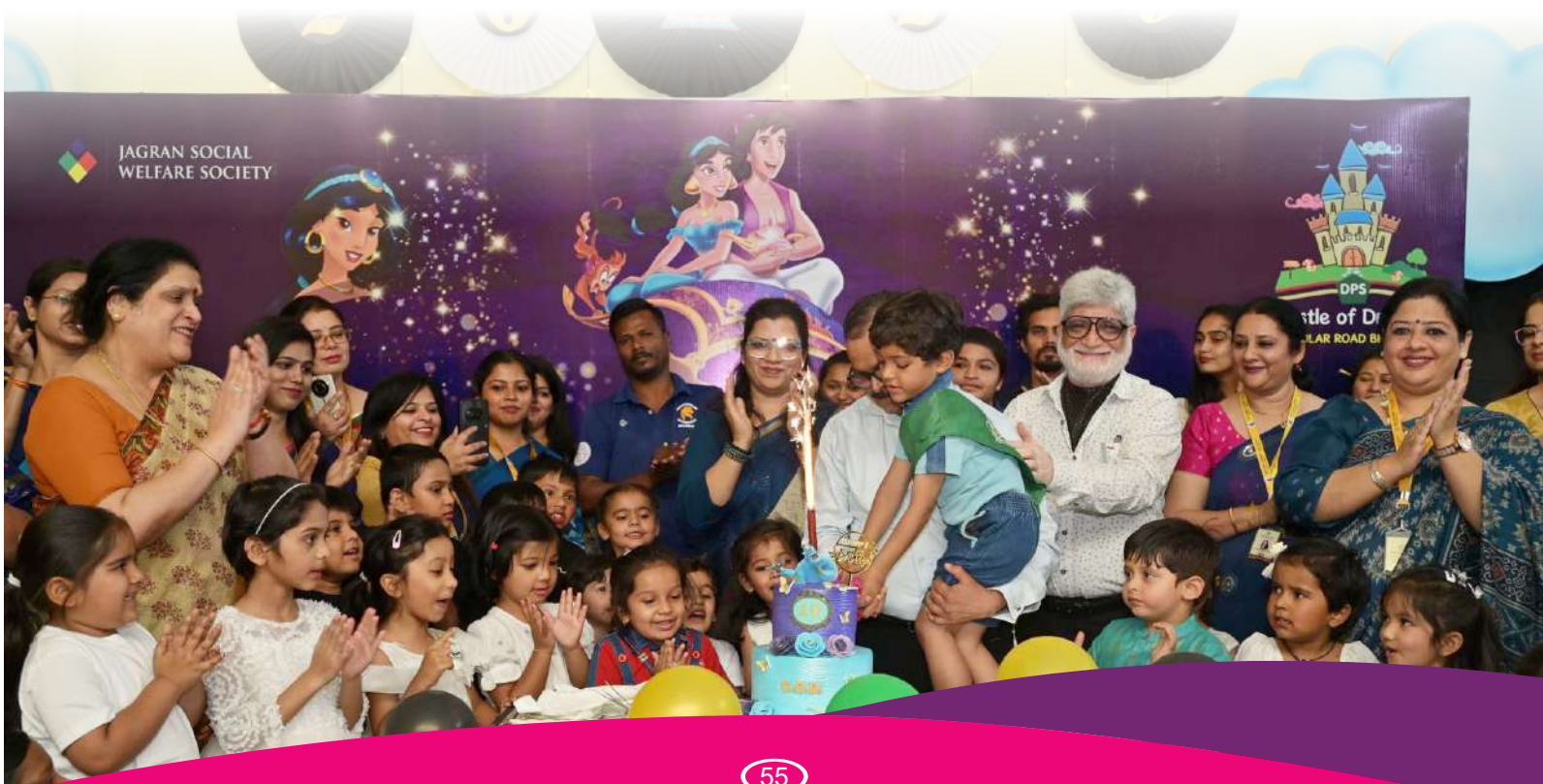
